Colorado Childcare Assistance Program (CCAP)

Colorado Childcare Assistance Program (CCAP)

The Colorado Childcare Assistance Program (CCAP) provides childcare assistance to families with lower incomes. It is administered by county so there are slightly different applications for Arapahoe, Adams, & Denver county.

Your family may be eligible to participate CCAP if you:

- Are working, looking for work, or participating in training/education
- Have at least one child who is under 13 years old (or 19 years old if the child has special needs or a disability & requires childcare)
- Have a qualifying family income

What Does CCAP Cover?

CCAP *may* pay for before and after care or summer programming @ Sewall. If you have older children in elementary or middle school, it *may* also pay for before and after school programming and summer camps.

How Do I Apply to CCAP & Related Programs?

You most often need to make sure a program accepts CCAP & apply for it AND also complete & submit a CCAP application.
